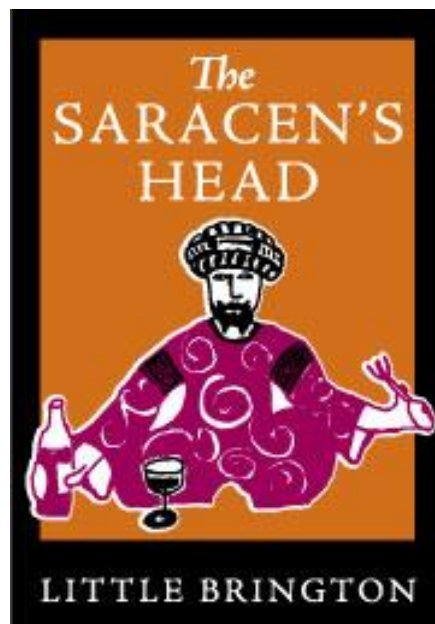

What is Tapas?

A 'Tapa' meaning lid or cover (or small plate), was thought to have originated from a piece of cheese or ham being given with a drink to put over the top of the drink to keep out the flies.

Tapas is not a particular type of food, anything can be tapas as long as it is small (and traditionally served with your drink).

Tapas is not a 'starter', if you start eating tapas, you finish eating tapas and stop only when you are full.

Although customarily thought of as Spanish many other countries have their version of tapas (small plates);

Mezze is from the Persian maza, meaning "taste, relish." The pleasure of savouring little pieces of food with wine, mezze is an appetizer or a spread of appetizers or small foods. Mezze is served either before or with dinner.

The English translation of mezze is appetizer, a small serving of food meant to stimulate the appetite before a meal.
